Results for 2011 Chevron City to Surf for Activ

The Chevron City to Surf for Activ saw record numbers with close to 42,000 people registering for WA's largest community sporting event.

The day also saw the biggest **marathon field in WA history** with numbers nearing 1,000 and the **biggest half marathon field in WA history** nearing 3,200.

To date the event has raised close to \$500, 000 for WA charities through the Activ Charity Challenge and this figure continues to rise. Fundraising remains open for one month after the event.

- Marathon – 993 - record field for the event
- Half Marathon – 3, 180 - record field for this event
- 12km Run/Walk – 27, 354
- 4km Run/Walk/Wheelchair – 10, 063

Participants can select from various events including the Marathon, Half Marathon, 12km Run/Walk, and 4km Run/Walk/Wheelchair.

The Marathon and Half Marathon courses are one of the most picturesque in the world, offering runners the opportunity to run past key Perth landmarks including the Swan River, Kings Park on to the beautiful Indian Ocean at City Beach, The Marathon, Half Marathon and 12km Run/ Walk races all start in Perth CBD on St Georges Terrace while the 4km has its start precinct at MacLean Park in Floreat. All races finish on West Coast Highway in City Beach.
